## Austria

### University of Applied Sciences Wiener Neustadt

*“As Lower Austria's largest University of Applied Sciences and one of the country's top educational institutions, we focus on practice-oriented education, international networking and innovative research work.*

*The University of Applied Sciences Wiener Neustadt offers international exchange students excellent opportunities to study in English in an international environment for one semester or a full academic year. We are perfectly located in the heart of Europe, in Wiener Neustadt, a city with 45,000 inhabitants, in proximity to the country's capital Vienna.”<sup>1</sup>*

Students are to apply for the *Bachelor in Business Consultancy International*, semester 4. The courses this semester is a fixed package of 18 ECTS and a specialization of 12 ECTS:

- International Management and Leadership (IML)
- International Accounting and Finance (IAF)
- International Marketing and Sales (IMS)

One academic semester of full time studies correspond to 30 ECTS.

This partner is suitable for the specialisations *Management* and *Accounting*.

## France

### INSEEC Grande Ecolé

INSEEC Grande Ecolé has three different campuses for exchange students: Paris, Bordeaux, and Lyon. It is important to note that exchange students are not guaranteed their first-choice campus as placement depends on course availability and number of places available. Additionally, not all campuses have historically been available during the application process.

INSEEC has a rather practical approach in teaching, where a majority of the teachers come directly from the industry. It is important to note that the semester might be shorter in comparison to other partner universities, but is also perceived as intense and students should be aware school days at INSEEC tend to be rather long. The schedule is never consistent due to the high level of practitioners and requires students to be flexible. It can even be so that lectures are held on a Saturday.

Students will apply to a fixed course package of 20 ECTS where students may influence the remaining 10 ECTS by choosing a track: Finance, Marketing, or Management. Although it says courses are taught at master's level, these are available for exchange students from Borås due to the academic structure of INSEEC. One academic semester of full time studies correspond to 30 ECTS.

This partner is suitable for all specialisations within your programme.

**Number of places:** 6 students per academic year (admission in spring only)  
2 places are dedicated to ACEKO

## Germany

The program consists of six courses with 5 ECTS credits each. Thus, students enrolled in the ISM Business Certificate program can earn 30 ECTS credits in one semester.

Every student at ISM is required to buy a semester ticket (valid for 6 months) of the local public transportation provider of approx. 210 € per semester.

## Hochschule München University of Applied Sciences (HM)

*“HM Hochschule München University of Applied Sciences is the second largest university of applied sciences in Germany. Our 18,000 students and our location in a leading European business centre afford fantastic opportunities, but also mean we have a responsibility in industrial, economic and social contexts.”<sup>3</sup>*

Students within your program study during from Summer semester (march-July). Business exchange students are to choose courses from Department 10 (Marketing student may also choose from Department 12).

Final course selection and registration do not take place until you have arrived in Munich. If you have to put together a Learning Agreement or Study Plan beforehand, please use the lecture timetables from the previous semester as a guide or ask your departmental coordinator at HM for advice. The Learning Agreement can be changed after the student has arrived.

One academic semester of full time studies correspond to 30 ECTS.

### ***“Courses in courselist are colour-coded***

*In order to help students with their course selection, our courses in English are classified as follows:*

- *Courses marked “green” are open to all (exchange) students from all departments.*
- *Courses marked “yellow” are open to all (exchange) students, but students enrolled in the department offering the course will be given priority.*
- *Courses marked “red” are only open to (exchange) students from the department offering the course.”*

## Reutlingen University

## Italy

### University of Bologna

University of Bologna is one of the world's oldest universities and consist of five different campuses, where Borås' exchange agreement is only valid for Campus Forlì. Students apply to courses within *Economics and Management*. Students should note that many courses relate to Economics (nationalekonomi) rather than Business Administration.

Exchange students from Borås may apply to courses at other campuses, however, minimum 50% of the courses must be at Campus Forlì. One academic semester of full time studies correspond to 30 ECTS.

This partner is suitable for all specialisations.

## The Netherlands

### Avans University of Applied Sciences

## Mexico

### Tecnológico de Monterrey

Monterrey, known for its business profile, is an enormous university with several (26) different campuses, scattered all over the country. Exchange students from Borås are allowed to choose campus of their preference, where students in the last years have chosen Campus Guadalajara. Thus, the information (e.g. study period) may differ depending on what campus you are looking at.

18 credits at Monterrey is equal to 30 ECTS. One academic semester of full time studies correspond to 30 ECTS.

This partner is suitable for all specialisations.

**Number of places:** 8 students per academic year.

## Republic of Korea

### INHA University

*“INHA University boasts a long tradition and heritage focusing on the natural sciences and engineering, and has produced generations of qualified engineers, entrepreneurs, and experts in various industrial sectors.*

*Incheon, INHA University’s hometown, especially since the opening of Incheon International Airport, is now gearing up to become a hub of international logistics and business for the Northeast Asian region.”<sup>9</sup>*

INHA University is located in Incheon, Korea’s third largest city by population (3 million). Seoul is located approximately one hour by metro, an affordable way for students to transport.

Exchange students from Borås are required to study minimum 6 courses, often corresponding to 18 INHA credits. Often, students must combine courses from different departments. In the application, exchange students apply for one department and will be given priority to these courses during registration. At the second step of the registration, exchange students may select courses from other departments as well, but on the principle first come, first served.

18 credits at INHA is equal to 30 ECTS. One academic semester of full time studies correspond to 30 ECTS. This partner is suitable for all specialisations.

- Organizational Behaviour (3 credits)
- Business Communication (3 credits)
- Digital Marketing (3 credits)
- Leadership (3 credits)
- Operations Management (3 credits)
- CSR Strategy & Cases (3 credits)

## Switzerland

Incoming exchange students may be informed they can receive a grant through the Swiss European Mobility Programme (SEMP), but since the Swedish Board of Student Finance (CSN) classifies this as a governmental scholarship, students from Sweden can no longer claim the SEMP grant.

This partner is suitable for the specialisation *Management and Accounting*.
